Based in Gweek, commanding panoramic views of the Helford River, the sanctuary is dedicated to seal rescue, rehabilitation and release, as well as raising awareness of how plastic pollution has affected our marine life in Cornwall. It also provides a forever home to animals needing permanent specialist care from the experts.

Meet the rescued seal pups going through rehabilitation during pup season in the winter, before being returned to the wild. See and hear about the resident animals and learn about their stories

This rambling granite and slate-stone home, high above the River Tamar, was built by the

Edgcumbes and remained in their family for near 600 years.

Time has stood still. The hall, with its ancient timber roof and displays of weaponry, and the warren of tapestry-clad rooms beyond have changed little since Tudor times.

The 12-acre garden features historic daffodils in the spring, terraces, ponds and orchards with over 125 local apple varieties.
